Arts: 1 credit

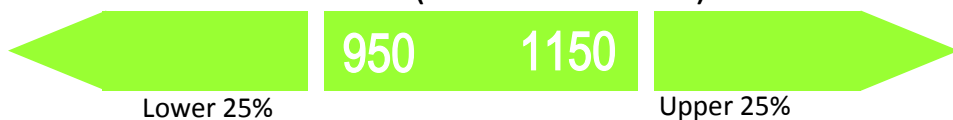

FRESHMAN CLASS PROFILE

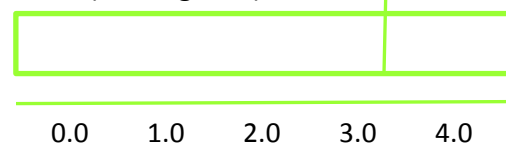
WSU SAT scores (1600 maximum)
